## Pocahontas

One English friend of Pocahontas was named John Smith. John was taken by the Powhatan. Smith said that when the Powhatan were about to hurt him, Pocahontas stopped them. After that, the **English knew Pocahontas** wanted peace. She could be trusted.

When Pocahontas was a young girl, English settlers came to start a town called Jamestown. Pocahontas wanted to make friends with the settlers and learn about them.
