Look at this picture.
The stars form a pattern.




We call this pattern of stars the Big Dipper. A dipper is like a ladle.

Stars can be different colors. White or blue stars are the hottest and brightest. Yellow stars are not as hot. Our sun is a yellow star. Red stars are cooler than other stars.



Stars can be different sizes. Red stars are usually the largest stars.



The way the moon looks has a pattern. These pictures show the pattern. The pattern starts over every 28 days. When you can barely see the moon at all, it is a new moon. When the moon looks like a circle, it is a full moon. Can you find the half moons?

An Upside-Down Drink

Gravity is what keeps things from flying into space. It keeps water in a glass, and it keeps you on Earth. There is no gravity in space.

WHAT YOU NEED

- a glass of water a chair
- a bendable straw

WHAT TO DO

- 1. Place the glass of water on the floor near the chair.
- 2. Lie across the chair on your stomach. Your head should be on the side where the water is. Ask a friend to hold the straw.
- 3. First, try to take a drink without using the straw.
- 4. Now try using the straw to take a drink.

WHAT HAPPENS - Gravity helps you eat and drink. It helps pull the food down toward your stomach. When you are lying across the chair, gravity is working against you. It is easier to use the straw.
