

Ruby Bridges becomes the first black student to attend an all-white elementary school in Louisiana.

April 15-17, 1960 Students form the Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee (SNCC).



October 1, 1962 James Meredith becomes the firstblack student to enroll at the University of Mississippi.



September 15, 1963 Four girls are killed in the bombing of the 16th Street Baptist Church in Birmingham, Alabama.





August 27, 1963 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. leads the March on Washington.




January 23, 1964 The 24th Amendment abolishes poll taxes.





Summer 1964 Known as "Freedom Summer' in Mississippi. Hundreds of students work for civil rights. Three are killed.



March 7, 1965 Demonstrators attempt to cross the Edmund Pettus Bridge in Selma, Alabama, but are attacked and beaten by police.

May 4, 1961 People participating in the Freedom Rides board buses, trains and planes to obtain equal treatment in interstate travel (as required by the Supremee Court). Hundreds go to jail.



The Children's Crusade-a march made by hundreds of school students-is attacked by police dogs and fire hoses in Birmingham, Alabama.

July 2, 1964 Civil Rights Act of 1964 becomes law, outlawing discrimination based on race, color or religion.



August 24-27, 1964 Fannie Lou Hamer and other members of the Mississippi Freedom Democratic Party demand to be seated at the Democratic National Convention in Atlantic City, New Jersey.





June 6, 1966 James Meredith begins the March Against Fear from Memphis, Tennessee to Jackson, Mississippi. He is shot on the second day of the march. Thousands rally to finish the march for him. This photo of Meredith, taken shortly after he was shot by Jack R. Thornell, won the Pulitzer Prize in 1967. Meredith survived the attack.
